Names will be shown alphabetically by maiden name for easy location. ***All proceeds will go towards furnishing the faculty lounge.***

Alumnae worldwide are encouraged to participate in this one-time, historical event that will have their names permanently displayed as a proud alumnae and contributor to the Dr. Inez Carnegie Faculty Lounge. Swans that have passed on may also be memorialized in this manner.

"Alumnae participation is a key factor in our ability to raise funds to support our alma mater and assist the upcoming cygnets," said Annette Stewart, chair of the membership committee. "I feel very strongly that St. Hugh's was instrumental in my journey towards achieving my goals and I will always support any effort to keep the Fidelitas banner flying high!"

Interest in the Inaugural Honor Roll is very high with at least 20% of the available name slots already taken. There is talk of a friendly competition to see which group will have the most names on the board. Some suggestions include challenges between alumnae chapters, graduating years, houses, and hostel girls versus non-boarders.
